- I. Introduction of members and new members.
- II. New Business:
 - 1. Information packets were given to all SHAC members explaining SHAC responsibilities. Selected School Health Statues Checklist was given to each member.
 - 2. Discussed the new SHAC guidelines as outlines in the Selected School Health Statues Checklist.
 - 3. Discussed Pandemic Flu Plan:
 - a. Seasonal flu shots will be offered to all faculty and community on October 6th, from 10:30- 12:30 in the nurse's office.
 - b. A tentative date for the H1N1 clinic was discussed with the Department of State Health Services. Carlisle School will partner with the DSHS and offer H1N1 vaccine to the students and community.
 - c. Health education was discussed on stopping the spread of flu and illness. The school nurse has been in each classroom and demonstrated effective ways to cover your cough, instruction was given on hand washing and recognizing symptoms of flu and illness.
 - d. Teachers were given packets of information on preparing for the Flu (Including the H1N1 Flu). Information also is posted on the school web-site.
 - e. Information on Flu (H1N1) was sent home in English and Spanish for each student. Information was also sent home on the school calendar.
 - 4. Diabetes Education was discussed and personnel that will need to be trained.
 - 5. Parent Concerns were discussed: The need for restroom stall doors in the Jr. High boy's restrooms. The High School Girls restroom.
